#### Rappings of the Gavel

We are making progress in updating our Constitution and By Laws to submit to the IRS so that we can be classified as a non-profit organization. However, changing the Constitution must be done under the old By Laws which specify that a quorum of two-thirds of the active membership must vote. This is a problem because we seldom, if ever, have two-thirds of the active members present at a regular meeting. Therefore, we must resort to an email vote on the changes.

As soon as we have all of the changes approved by the Executive Board, the text of the revised Constitution and By Laws will be sent to all active members by email (or regular mail for those without email). Please vote for or against the changes by return email or regular mail.

It will be a while before you receive the final document because we are working on the proper wording for the quorum required for voting in the future.

#### **Board Meeting**
